- 2:30 pm Drive to Kitsap Unitarian Universalist Fellowship, 4418 Perry Ave., Bremerton for nonviolence training, dinner, and sleep-over.
- 3 -5:30 pm Nonviolence training and action prep
- 5:30 pm Spaghetti dinner provided by Ground Zero
- 6:30 -9 pm More action prep and sleep-over at the Kitsap Unitarian Universalist Fellowship

- 4:30 am Leave Kitsap Unitarian Universalist Fellowship for Ground Zero
- 5:00 am Circle at Ground Zero
- 5:15 am Leave to walk to Bangor gate
- 5:45 am Vigil at Bangor gate
- 6:00 am Nonviolent direct action at Bangor gate
- 6:45 am Leave gate to return to Ground Zero
- 7:15 am Closing circle at Ground Zero
- 7:30 am Drive back to the Kitsap Unitarian Universalist Fellowship
- 8:00 am Provided breakfast, debriefing, and evaluation  
Wait for return of arrestees (we hope all would be back by noon)



## What to bring:

Sack lunch for Sunday, sleeping needs, snacks, drinking water, umbrella, flashlight, warm, waterproof clothes, pictures or phrases for a banner on the theme, sign-making materials; money to buy t-shirts and bumper stickers and to donate to the work of Ground Zero. Ground Zero will provide dinner on Sunday night and breakfast on Monday morning. Rides also provided from Ground Zero to the gate for those who can't comfortably walk.
